# Volunteer Opportunities

- Box Tops**– Volunteers help earn money for our school by promoting the collection drive, properly cutting the collected box tops and preparing them to be mailed each October and February.
- Chicken Biscuit Sales** - Each Wednesday morning two volunteers sell Chick-fil-A Chicken Biscuits from 8:15-9:30
- Duty Free Lunch**- Volunteers monitor the cafeteria during school lunch hours once per month to allow teachers to eat lunch in peace & quiet.
- FroYo Friday**– Help administration sell frozen yogurt to students from 8:15-9:15
- Fun Friday**- Our Wildcat behavior incentive event on designated Friday afternoons allows the students free time outside to be kids. Volunteers are needed for each grade level to sell snacks.
- General Volunteers**- Events always come up at the last minute or committees might need extra help. We use general volunteers to help us fill in throughout the year.
- Grade Level Dances**– It takes many hands to plan each grade level dance from decorations, food, and games to set up, chaperoning and clean up. Dances are held in the spring.
- Honor Roll Celebrations**- After each nine weeks, the students with all A/B's and S's in conduct celebrate with a fun event. Volunteers are needed to help plan and chaperone during school hours.
- Hospitality**– Help spoil our staff by bringing in store bought or homemade treats and serving them several times during the year.
- Membership**- Sign up families, students and staff as PTSA members during the Meet & Greet before school starts. Gather local business coupons to distribute in membership packages. Organize membership drive campaign in September. Enter membership information in database.
- Olympics**– This week long, field day type event needs volunteers in March to help sell t-shirts and in May to provide water and other assistance to the athletes.
- Red Ribbon Week**– This national program takes place in October. Volunteers help promote being drug-free by creating and advertising daily themes and distributing Red Ribbon items throughout the week.
- Reflections**– Support the arts in this national competition by getting information to students about the contest. Assistance is also needed to help coordinate judges, prepare art work for submission and deliver/pick up art as needed. Most work takes place in the Fall.
- School Store**– Each morning 2-3 volunteers open the school store from 8:30-9:30 allowing students to purchase items needed during the school day.
- Spirit Night**– Help is needed to coordinate and promote Spirit Nights/Take Out Tuesdays. These happen periodically throughout the school year.
